- 4. Expenses are recognised in statement of profit and loss using a classification based on the nature of expense method as per para 99 of Ind AS 1, Presentation of financial statements
- Interest of Rs.1.53 Lacs against dealership deposits has not been provided for the current quarter.
- 6.Considering the Operations of the Company only small Number of employees are employed and inview ofthis the requirements of Ind AS-19 Employee Benefits in respect of gratuity could not be complied with. However provision for gratuity as required under Payment of Gratuity Act has been provided for and is being paid as and when the liability arises.
- The above mentioned income from operations are disclosed net of GST Collected.
- 8. Despite profits, no provision is made for tax considering unabsorbed depreciation and brought forward losses both under book profits provisions and Income tax Provisions.
- 9. Deferred tax is not considered keeping in view the probability that the company may not earn taxable profits in the near future.
- 10. The Company is engaged in Trading in LPG and leasing out bottling plants temporarily. There are no other reportable segments as per Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS 108).
- 11. Corresponding period figures have been regrouped / recasted wherever necessary to conform with those of current period.
